**Sub.:-** Suggestions for Improvement of Law and Order in the City.

Respected Madam,

Chandigarh Beopar Mandal on behalf of traders of city would like to put forward some of suggestion for improvement of Law and Order in the city and especially in and around the markets.

- 1. Strengthening of Beat System:-** Police Beat system should be improved and Police personnel presence should be insured in the markets especially in the late evening hours. Extra staff should be deployed for Court cases and security during rallies and dharnas etc. Beat staff should remain in touch with all prominent persons in the markets and sector residents. This will help in improving law and order position in the city.
- 2. Night Patrolling:-** Police staff should deployed for night patrolling in and around the markets and also to keep watch on chowkidars deployed by the Market Associations. Police verification of chowkidars should be done on priority.
- 3. Unauthorized Vendors:-** Vendors of food, Momo's, Chole Bhatura, Juice, Helmet and other household goods occupy prime parking area of markets. Food stalls even use gas cylinders thereby endangering public safety. They should be removed or shifted to vendor zones already earmarked by the Municipal Corporation. Sometimes these vendors fight with shopkeepers and create law and order problem in the markets.
- 4. Beggar Menace:-** Beggars should be prohibited from light points and markets for smooth flow of traffic. Sometimes children are also encouraged to do begging by their parents or anti social elements. Sometime these baggers also commit thefts from the Cars.

5. **Regular Co-ordination Meetings:-** Quarterly meeting of Police and Traders of the markets should be held in each Police Station or some other public place under the command of concerned SHO or DSP so that we can raise issues concerned with law and order. In case of any dispute between customers and shopkeepers, the President and General Secretary should be involved to sort out the problem amicably. We should be apprised of all policy decision of the Police (other than secret one) so that Public is made aware accordingly for implementation. We are ready to provide to the department list of office bearers of Market Associations
6. **Thefts in the Markets:-** In case of any theft in the markets, Police should actively involve itself in arresting the culprits. If case is not resolved within a reasonable time, easy process and time limit be settled for lodging claim of loss by the traders. In sector 11 market three theft cases are still lying unresolved.
7. **Landlord-Tenant Disputes:-** Police should insure neutral role in commercial property disputes with tenants and also see that no commercial tenant is uprooted forcefully.
8. **Reward to Honest Person:-** A scheme to reward honest and genuine Police and Public person should be initiated so that such type of persons are encouraged for there being good human being.

So you are requested to look into the above suggestions sympathetically and implement it for improvement in law and order in the city.
